**** 72 hours-The time in the tomb must be a full 72 hours or 3 full days and nights. Counting partial days is a rabbinic tradition and is false. Since these Shabbat dates never line up with Saturday year after year, we can see the Yahushua & The Jews of His day basing their 7th day on the Turn of the Year, as with all other days according to Torah in Genesis 1:14-19! The Aviv-OT-Spring Echanok, is always on Yom Shleshee which is NOT the same thing as Tuesday and Aviv 1 is always on Yom Revee, which is NOT the same thing as Wednesday. Failure to see or admit this will leave anyone and everyone in a perpetual cloud regarding correctly discerning time!
