

THE FEAST OF NEW WINE-From Malkitzedek to Yahusha!

Exodus 34:22 And you shall observe Chag Shavuot, of the bikkurim of the wheat harvest, and the feasts of gathering in the middle of the year and the chag of the ingathering-Sukkot at the turn of the year.

Gen 14:18 18 And Malki-Tzedek melech of Salem brought out lechem and wine: and he was the kohen of El-Elyon.

Genesis 27:27-29

Genesis 49: 8 Yahudah, you are he whom your brothers shall hallel: your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies; your abba's children shall bow down before you.

9 Yahudah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, you have gone up: he stooped down; he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?

10 The scepter shall not depart from Yahudah nor a lawgiver from between His feet, until Shiloh comes and the things reserved for Him; to Him shall the gathering and the expectation of the nations be.

11 Binding his foal to the vine, and his donkey's colt to the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the dahm of grapes:

12 His eyes shall be red with wine, and his teeth white with milk.

Deut. 7: 13 All the best of the oil, and all the best of the wine, and of the wheat, the bikkurim of what they shall offer to אֲנִי, I have given to you

Wine-grapes was the key ingredient in the sacrifices

Deut. 11:12 All the best of the oil, and all the best of the wine, and of the wheat, the bikkurim of what they shall offer to אֲנִי, I have given to you

Deut 11:14 You shall shomer Chag Sukkot seven days, after you have gathered in your corn and your wine:

Deut 18:4 The bikkurim also of your corn, of your wine, and of your oil, and the first of the fleece of your sheep, shall you give him.

Deut 32:14 Butter of cattle, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the finest of wheat; and you did drink the pure dahm of the grape, the tov wine.

Grapes point to blood! Of The Lion of Judah!

Isaiah 27:2 In that yom shir to her, A vineyard of red wine.

3 I אֲנִי do keep it; I will water it every moment: lest any hurt it, I will keep it night and yom.

Isaiah

55: 1 Hello, every one that thirsts, come to the mayim; and he that has no money; come, buy, and eat; yes, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

2 Why do you spend money for that which is not lechem? And your labor for that which does not satisfy?
Listen diligently to Me, and eat that which is tov, and let your being delight itself in fatness.

Isaiah 63:1 Who is this that comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? This that is with tifereth in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength? It is I that speak in tzedakah, mighty to save.

2 Why are you red in Your apparel, and Your garments like him that tramples in the winepress?

Isiah 65: 8 This says אַיָּאֵל, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one says, Destroy it not; for a bracha is in it: so will I do for My avadim's sakes, that I may not destroy them all.

Jeremiah 31:11 For אַיָּאֵל has redeemed Yaakov, and ransomed him from the hand of him that was stronger than he.

12 Therefore they shall come and shir in the heights of Tzion, and shall flow together to the tov of אַיָּאֵל, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their being shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.

13 Then shall the virgin gilah in the dance, both young men and old together: for I will turn their mourning into simcha, and will comfort them, and make them gilah from their sorrow.

14 And I will fill the beings of the Kohanim with fatness, and My people shall be satisfied with My tov, says אַיָּאֵל.
