38 And afterward Moshe went into the gan of Reuel that was behind the house, and he there prayed to YHWH his Elohim, who had done mighty wonders for him.

39 And it was that while he prayed he looked opposite to him, and behold a sapphire stick was placed in the ground, which was planted in the midst of the gan.

40 And he approached the stick and he looked, and behold the Name of YHWH Elohim of hosts was engraved thereon, written and developed upon the stick.

41 And he read it and stretched forth his hand and he plucked it like a forest tree from the thicket, and the stick was in his hand.

42 And this is the stick with which all the works of our Elohim were performed, after he had created the shamayim and earth, and all the host of them, seas, rivers and all their fishes.

43 And when Elohim had driven Ahdam from Gan Aden, he took the stick in his hand and went and tilled the ground from which he was taken.

44 And the stick came down to Noach and was given to Shem and his descendants, until it came into the hand of Avraham the Ivri.

45 And when Avraham had given all he had to his son Yitzchak, he also gave to him this stick.

46 And when Yaakov had fled to Padan-Aram, he took it into his hand, and when he returned to his abba he had not left it behind him.

47 Also when he went down to Mitzrayim he took it into his hand and gave it to Yoseph, one portion above his brothers, for Yaakov had taken it by force from his brother Esav.

48 And after the death of Yoseph, the nobles of Mitzrayim came into the house of Yoseph, and the stick came into the hand of Reuel the Midyanite, and when he went out of Mitzrayim, he took it in his hand and planted it in his gan.

49 And all the mighty men of the Kenites tried to pluck it when they endeavored to get Tzipporah his daughter, but they were unsuccessful.

50 So that stick remained planted in the gan of Reuel, until he came who had a right to it and took it.

51 And when Reuel saw the stick in the hand of Moshe, he wondered about it, and he gave him his daughter Tzipporah for a wife.

YHWH always used what He placed and found in the hands of our patriarchs!

Amazingly it was the SAME rod that would one day become the rod of Moshe.

the principle being that when YHWH places His purpose in your hands, you cannot be defeated!

One stick-Shemot- Chapter 4: 2, 3, 17-YHWH will take what you have NOW and use it for His purposes as long as you make it available to him! Is it available for His use?

What do you have that has not been turned over to YHWH? All 10 plagues and the splitting of the sea were done with what Moshe already had, not with what YHWH provided him with.

YHWH takes the mundane and turns it into the extraordinary for, signs, wonders, redemption, deliverance and judgement. What is in your hands already that YHWH desires to use?

A little shepherd's rod defeated the mightiest nation on earth.

A handful of flour in a bin,

and a little oil in a jar- Melachim Alef/First Kings 17: 9, 13, 14, 15, 16 The poor

widow woman thought that her food

was not enough for herself and her son and that it would only suffice for them to die without pain.

How then could she turn what little she had in her hand to the man of YHWH? YHWH sustains with what we already have and multiplies what's already in our hands if we obey Him in emunah!

He does not ask us for what He has not given us.

**5 stones and a slingshot in David's hand defeated the entire Plishtim army-
Schmuel Alef/First Samuel 17: 39 , 40, 45 , 46, 47, 48 , 49 50 ,51**

Not Saul's expensive armor but a pouch a stone and a slingshot. Dawid used what he had.

So that it's not the potency of your weapon or size of your gifts but YHWH's ruach that takes what you offer to Him!! YHWH the true giant had slain a champion not a giant! You and I are the giants because with YHWH nothing shall be impossible to him that believes!

A single jawbone in Shimshon's hand-Shophtim 15:14, 15, 16, 17,

Matthew 14: 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 But *Yahshua* said to them, *They need not depart; you give them to eat.*

Yahshua told His talmidim to use what was already in their hands! He wasn't about to cook!

Why because by emunah they turned over what they had to the Master. With YHWH nothing shall be impossible!

Mattiyahu/Matthew 15: 32, 33, 34 , 35, 36, 37, 38 38 And they that did eat were four thousand men, beside women and children. Why because by emunah they turned over what they had to the Master. With YHWH nothing shall be impossible! Yochanan Moshe/Mark 12: 42, 43, 44, 43 She used the two coins already in her hand.

Shemot/Exodus 16:17, 18

With what was collected in their hand YHWH fed the entire family and nation. For with YHWH nothing shall be impossible!

Close-Luka/Luke1: 37 For with YHWH nothing shall be impossible. Mattiyahu 17:20 And Yahshua said to them, *for truly I say to you, If you have emunah as a grain of mustard zera, you shall say to this mountain, Remove from here to there; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible to you. If you utilize what's already been entrusted to you, you will see the impossible , since it is YHWH who uses what's in your hands already to create the impossible. He is the author of the impossible but you and I are the conduits of the impossible.*
